

Paperwork

Anonymising

Please ensure ALL paperwork is anonymised (except contact details, see also below, and consent forms). Please also ensure you write the full trial ID (format C000/0000/XXX) so the Team can identify the patient.

Please make sure this anonymisation is done in such a way that it cannot be read by the scanner/fax machine: modern laser printers create raised areas which a pen or marker will not cover.

Patient Details Forms

We are receiving an increasing number of incorrect and/or illegible patient details forms: please ensure these are COMPLETE, fully LEGIBLE and CORRECT, as these details are **vital** to perform the final outcome investigation. Please also refer to September 2015's newsletter for details on *completeness*.

Randomisation CRF

The validation on the Randomisation eCRF has been updated to ensure recruitment of patients who have had an MRI diffusion weighted imaging (DWI) undertaken which shows a positive lesion compatible with their clinical presentation is now possible.

Sending patient information

We understand that a number of sites are no longer able to fax patient details to the Trials Office. We are in process of setting up an NHS.net account which can receive data securely from other NHS.net accounts. If you are able to fax patient details, please continue to do so. We will let you know when the NHS.net account is up and running.







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Payment

Please note that you cannot be paid for participants until we have received all the brain imaging as detailed on the CRFs.

Clinical scans

Remember that any scan taken between randomisation and Day 90 needs to be submitted on the Additional Brain Imaging CRF as well as uploaded.

Travel receipts

If you need to claim for travel expenses for participants (for Day 7 and 35 follow-ups), you must send receipts to us as soon as possible. These should also be anonymised with the participant trial ID in the format C000/0000/XXX as standard.

Screening logs

These **MUST** be sent monthly: it as a legal Sponsor requirement.

Blood logs

Please ensure that you also send the completed trial Blood Freezer Logs when sending blood samples to the Trials Office.
