The IDMC 's recommendations are:

a) The study should continue without change to the protocol,

b) Now that the study is well advanced and the major changes to the protocol established, a detailed Statistical Analysis Plan should be developed. Although this is the responsibility of the Steering Committee, the IDMC would like to have sight of this plan.
