Adoption by the Stroke Research Network of study: “Triple Antiplatelets for Reducing Dependency after Ischaemic Stroke” (TARDIS)

The Stroke Research Network (SRN) Study Adoption Committee considered the above study at its meeting on 6 March 2009, and I am pleased to inform you that the Committee has agreed that the study should be adopted to the SRN portfolio, subject to the following conditions:

- SRN will provide support for the first 350 patients at which point the study can be submitted for further review.
- SRN support will be provided in the form of identification, recruitment (with PI support) and follow-up of patients, and entry of trial data onto the study website, as requested in the application.

One of the conditions of adoption onto the SRN portfolio is that details of adopted studies are held in the UKCRN portfolio database and you will be
