



GCP Online Training for Sites

The UKCRN have confirmed that staff at sites participating in any adopted trials, including the TARDIS trial, can use their free online NIHR CRN Good Clinical Practice (GCP) training course/s.

and then choose the appropriate GCP course (new staff, experienced etc).

Individuals will need to register with UKCRN first if not already done so, and then sign up for the course, both at the following website:

When registering, you will need to select your Hospital site's local LRN from a drop down box. The Network Manager in your site's local geographic area will be the authorising agent.

The request will then be sent to the SRN for approval and you will receive an email with confirmation and sign up details.
